From Highway 101:

South from san jose- take the San Martin avenue exit and go East on San Martin Ave. Exit the freeway and turn left, go over the freeway towards the hills. Continue 1.5 miles through a few stop signs. The last street with a stop sign you will cross is Foothill Ave. A couple hundred feet past the parking entrance to the Harvey Bear Park parking lot you will turn to the left on a dirt driveway. Signs and ribbons will be posted. Do not enter the County Park parking lot. If you take a sharp turn to the right on New Ave you have missed the entrance.

North from Gilroy- take the San Martin avenue exit and go East on San Martin Ave. Exit the freeway and turn right, head towards the hills. Continue 1.5 miles through a few stop signs. The last street with a stop sign you will cross is Foothill Ave. A couple hundred feet past the parking entrance to the Harvey Bear Park parking lot you will turn to the left on a dirt driveway.
